It is important for all students - and parents/carers - to know that our uniform is exactly that: uniform. It does not include fashion or designer items, which are not acceptable at CWLC.

Blazers: specialist item. D Luke Premium Navy blue blazer.

Trousers: black or charcoal grey conventional school trousers. Jeans, jogging bottoms, leggings, or skin-tight trousers in any colour are not permitted.

Skirt: students may choose to wear a skirt instead of trousers. This must now be purchased from our suppliers Monkhouse or KITZ UK. Knee-length tailored shorts can also be worn.

Shirts: white, collar suitable for a tie, short or long sleeved and worn tucked in and with a House tie. Optional student 'Rever' shirt must be worn with a House pin badge.

Jumper: plain navy blue v-neck jumper worn under a blazer but not instead of it.

House pins: specialist item. A house colour pin badge must be worn with school 'Rever' shirt (instead of a tie).

Shoes: plain black, traditional/conventional school-style. Not black trainers.

Socks/Tights: plain dark grey or black should be worn.

Outdoor coats: should be appropriate for the time of year. Tracksuit tops or hoodies are not acceptable items of school wear.

Jewellery: students may wear ONE plain stud in each ear. No other piercings other than the ear lobes are allowed. No other jewellery or piercings are permitted and students will be asked to remove any incorrect jewellery, which can then be collected from reception at the end of the day.

Hairstyles: these should be appropriate for school, without extreme cuts, styles, lines or colours. Long hair must be tied up for practical subjects.

Make-up: should not be worn by students in years 7, 8 or 9. Discreet make-up is allowed in years 10 and 11. Nail varnish, false nails and/or false eyelashes are not allowed.
