



Home School Agreement

CWLC agrees to:

- Welcome you and offer opportunities for you to attend school and become involved with the life of the school.
- Support your child's wellbeing and safety by providing a safe, supportive and caring environment.
- Help and encourage your child to reach their full potential on their five or seven year journey.
- Monitor and update your child's progress at online progress meetings and termly reports to parents.
- Communicate any concerns about your child's attendance/behaviour/wellbeing with you as their parent or carer, and respond to any concerns from your child or parents/carers.
- Provide a broad and ambitious curriculum that caters for all children.
- Promote high standards of behaviour, and outline clear expectations in our behaviour policy so we can maintain a safe environment for all children.
- Set homework that supports the delivery of the curriculum and mark it where appropriate.
- Communicate between home and school through a variety of methods.
- Respond to communications from parents and carers in a timely manner, following school policies.
- Set and achieve high standards of work and behaviour through building good relationships, encouraging leadership and developing a sense of responsibility.
- Promote a wide range of extra-curricular activities.
- Keep you informed about school activities through the calendar, website, letters home, bulletin and newsletters.

Parents/carers agree to:

- Ensure my child attends school regularly and on time at 8:30am. I will notify the school daily if my child will be absent, giving the reason inline with the attendance policy.
- Meet with the attendance team if my child's attendance falls below 90% and agree steps to improve this.
- Ensure my child is in the correct uniform. If there is a problem with uniform, I will contact my child's Learning Mentor or write a note in their planner, stating the issue and how it will be resolved.
- Ensure my child brings the necessary equipment to school.
- Support the school to make sure my child maintains a consistently high standard of behaviour.
- Encourage my child to try their best so they can reach their full potential.
- Communicate to the school any concerns that I have about my child that may affect their behaviour in school or ability to learn.
- Ensure communication with the school is respectful, and that I make every reasonable effort to address my communications to the appropriate member of staff.
- Attend online progress evenings and meetings about my child's progress.
- Attend events at school to understand and support my child through their education.
- Refrain from taking my/our child out of school for holidays/days out.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour as set out in the behaviour policy and this Home School Agreement.

- Do my homework on time and raise any issues with my teachers.

- Understand and follow the school rules.
- Look after school equipment, and show respect for the school environment and local community.
